## **JOURNEY TO THE CROSS FEBRUARY 26 THROUGH April 6**

We are approaching our Lord's Passion Week, His crucifixion, and His Resurrection. Palm Sunday is April 1 and Easter is April 8. There are six Sundays before we celebrate our Lord's victory over death on Easter. Our services leading up to this most blessed of our Christian celebrations will prepare us to understand and participate in it with hearts of faith. In music, in scriptures, in sermons – we will prepare our hearts through worship. This is one of the best outreach times of the year to the unchurched. We will have the added excitement this year of inviting people to come to the first Sunday in our new building and the Dedication a few weeks later. Remember that a person who does not regularly attend church will respond to someone they know and trust who invites them.

## **UPDATE ON OUR NEW BUILDING**

This week the sanding and staining in the Sanctuary is under way. The tile has been laid in the social hall. The kitchen cabinets have been delivered along with the sound control console. The stained glass windows will be delivered in about four weeks. The baptistery has been put in place. The platform is being finished. The landscaping plants have been delivered. Yet to be done is lighting in the Sanctuary, carpet, and installing the sound system. Most of the furnishings have been acquired and will be delivered when the building is ready.

## **A GOOD BEGINNING FOR THE CHOIR**
